In the re-allocation scheme approved by the Government, C.Os. have been sanctioned Head Constables as their readers. Some time back, this question was discussed whether the Head Constables could efficiently carry out duties of readers to the C.Os. and on this opinions of the various Range D.Is.G. were called. Almost all the D.Is.G. have suggested that Brevet Jamadars who have the necessary Police experience will be good enough to work as readers. Brevet Jamadars are, for all practical purposes, Head constables with long service and good record.

It is, therefore, ordered that in future the readers to the C.Os. will be of the rank of Brevet Jamadars. The D.Is.G. may please appoint suitable B.Js as readers to the C.Os. out of their Range and where difficulty is felt, a reference might be made to this office.
