

STANDING ORDER NO. 5

Subject:- Departmental enquiries.

From the 1st May 1957, all D.Is.G.P. should please submit monthly statements to the P.H.Q. <sup>showing</sup> stating therein the departmental enquiries which <sup>are</sup> ~~were~~ pending with them ~~at~~ the beginning of the month. Every pending D.E. should be mentioned in the statements with the following details :-

- (a) Name and No. of the defaulter with his District.
- (b) ~~charges framed against the defaulter~~
- (c) Date of receipt of the departmental enquiry in the D.Is.G.P.'s office <sup>or date of</sup>
- (d) <sup>starting</sup> ~~the D.E.~~ if the D.I.G. is himself holding it.
- (e) Reasons <sup>why</sup> the D.E. is pending, <sup>for more than 2 months.</sup>

2. The statements sent on the 1st of every month <sup>above</sup> should contain all <sup>pending</sup> cases in the D.Is.G.P.'s office even if they are mentioned or repeated in the previous statements. <sup>They should be continued to be shown until they are disposed of.</sup>

3. The <sup>above</sup> statements should be received in the P.H.Q. by the 7th of every month. The first statement should come by the 7th May 1957.
