Reference this office Standing Order No.6 dated 4th 1957 on the above subject.

2. No reference was made in the above Standing Order about officers or men on deputation to C.I.D., Anti Corruption, Intelligence Bureau, New Delhi, Special Police Establishment of the Government of India, Railway Protection Force etc. As ~~however~~ <sup>are usually</sup> only good officers and men ~~will hereafter~~ be sent on deputation as above, it should be presumed that they are all fit for promotion in their turn. As such they must not be superseded under any circumstances <sup>in their home Dist. or Ranges.</sup> Promotions should be given to them when their turn <sup>comes</sup> and the officer under whom they are on deputation as well as <sup>they themselves</sup> ~~the promoted man or officer~~ should be informed promptly of this promotion.

3. Complaints are occasionally coming of supersession of officers and men on deputation <sup>hence</sup> this Standing Order being issued.
