STANDING ORDER NO. 4/85

Sub- Recruitment of Constables in CP/AP/R.A.C.-
Screening and policy for leave, Discharge etc.

In supersession of Para 3 of Standing Order No. 10/76 issued vide this office No.N.5(4)DIGP/TRG/74-76/4830-4908 dt. 13.4.76 and Order No.A.12(10)IGP/TRG/Force/83/5712 dt. 3.6.85, the following orders are issued in regard to absence of Recruit Constables during the period of their initial training at Police Training Institutions :-

- (A) If a recruit overstays sanctioned leave he may be taken back on duty (training) only if there are sufficient and unavoidable reasons for the same and his case will be regularized by sanctioning leave according to rules. If there are no such satisfactory reasons, he will be sent back to the competent authority for discharge from service.
- (B) In case of illness, if the trainee produces appropriate medical certificate alongwith leave application and there is no doubt about its genuineness, he may be taken on duty and leave due be sanctioned by appropriate authority. In case the genuineness is doubtful, the recruit may be permitted to join and enquiries be got conducted. If on enquiry, the recruit is found to have been really sick during the period, his leave will be sanctioned as in para (A) above.
- (C) In case after enquiries, there is reasonable doubt about such illness, the recruit will be sent back for being discharged by competent authority.
- (D) If a recruit while at the training institution, falls ill or is declared unfit by the doctor to attend training, comments of the Medical Officer of the Training Institution concerned shall be obtained regarding the duration of treatment when the recruit could be physically fit ^{to} undergo proper training. If this period is more than 30 days, the recruit shall be returned to the competent authority for being sent for training alongwith the next batch.
- (E) If a recruit absents from training without permission for more than seven days, he shall

be deemed unfit to be retained in Police Service and shall be recommended for discharge to the competent authority.

(F) If there is a difference of opinion on any of the aforesaid issues between the head of the training institution and the Concerned Competent authority, the matter will be referred to I.G.P. (Trg.), whose decision will be final.
