CIRCULAR ORDER NO. 106.

Majority of the cattle thefts are not being reported to the Police and the complainants manage to get back the cattle by paying 'Khuri' (return money). Unless we take action against these x middle men, who arrange for this Khuri this type of offences will not go down. Every S.P. should have a list of such persons in each Police Station and arrange to take action against them for receiving stolen property or under section 110 Cr.P.C. & open their history sheets.

2. The Rules under the Habitual offenders Act will soon be published. Every S.P. should now get the names approved by the district Magistrate for placing them under the Habitual Offenders Act. In these lists prominence should be given to those, who arrange for Khuri and those who indulge in crime against property. This should be taken up by the Ss.P. and as soon as the rules are published they should see the D.Ms. and get necessary orders passed early. A copy of the list should be sent to me and the C.I.D. by each S.P.
